ANIMALS USE NATURE TO HEAL THEMSELVES

Animals wounded in the wild or hit by disease have an amazing ability to treat their disease, according to new research that has important benefits 0 humans.

Examples of this new work include findings with monkeys that rub their fur with ants containing insect-killing chemicals; chimpanzees who eat the top of the plant *Vernonia amygdalina* 19 kill stomach worms; and domestic cats which eat houseplants or chew woolly jumpers to make themselves sick and so clean their bodies 20 poisons. Even more surprisingly, scientists have found that some animals are able to help people to overcome diseases. 'Dogs are particularly good 21 this,' said Professor Keith Kendrick, of the Babraham Institute in Cambridge. 'They have an excellent sense of smell and can detect when chemical changes take place in their owners. Dogs can tell long 22 the event when a person is going to have an epileptic attack. Obviously that is a talent with very important advantages.' Kendrick this week begins a series of public lectures 23 animal senses at Gresham College, London. Another favourite animal habit 24 has recently been discovered by scientists is eating dirt to kill bacteria. It is favoured by mountain gorillas and chimpanzees. 'The stuff is excellent 25 you have had a stomach bug or something similar,' said Dr Cindy Engel, whose book, *Wild Health*, is published by Phoenix this month.
